Thank you for submitting your request for a rule exemption request relating to wetsuit usage at higher water temperatures at the below events:

- Ardingly Swim the Lake (Alpha) 05.06.2024
- Ardingly Swim the Lake (Beta) 17.07.2024

Based on the on the below additional mitigation being implemented, the Technical Committee have approved that British Triathlon Competition Rule 4.2.a is amended to state that wetsuits are optional and/or mandatory up to 22°C, beyond this they are banned.
